Impact in Appleton

Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin provides affordable, quality, and confidential health care to 2,017 patients at our Appleton health center. In 2018, there were over 2,800 patient visits for health care services. Of the patients we served in Appleton, 39% lived below the federal poverty level, and at least 77% were Medicaid eligible. Planned Parenthood is the largest community based reproductive health care provider in Appleton.

PPWI's Community Education Department provided 915 sexuality education programs and trainings for nearly 18,000 participants in 2018. PPWI provides education workshops in schools and community settings, home health parties, health fairs and other outreach events, and professional training opportunities.
